Justices of the Peace are an integral part of Ontario's justice system and of its communities. Justices of the Peace make decisions that affect local communities, and participate in the outreach efforts that connect citizens with the justice system. Along with others in the justice system, the Association of Justices of the Peace of Ontario recognizes the importance of fostering interest and aspiration in young people to pursue the many diverse careers in the justice sector.

Therefore, the Association of Justices of the Peace of Ontario (AJPO) has allocated funding to create the Association of Justices of the Peace Bursary. This bursary will provide direct support to students in secondary school who have enrolled in a post-secondary institution and who plan to pursue a career in the justice sector. The Justice of the Peace bursary program will help students make the transition from secondary school to university or college. Students must demonstrate financial need, but do not have to have applied for a student loan. One student from each of the seven Ontario Court of Justice regions will be awarded a bursary annually
