## Ontario Superior Court Judges' Association




The Superior Court of Justice is one of the busiest trial courts in the world. The Court has jurisdiction over criminal, civil, and family cases, and is the largest superior trial court in Canada. The Divisional Court, Small Claims Court, and Family Court are all branches of the Superior Court of Justice.

The Superior Court of Justice sits in 52 locations across Ontario in addition to numerous satellite locations. These court sites are organized into eight judicial regions and different services in accordance with the Superior Court's jurisdiction over civil, criminal, family, Small Claims Court and Divisional Court proceedings.
